

DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

(East Midlands Patient and Public Involvement Senate)

The NHS Code of Accountability requires Board directors to declare interests that are relevant and material to the NHS Board of which they are a member. All existing Board directors should declare such interests. Any Board directors appointed subsequently should do so on appointment. Whilst the East Midlands PPI Senate is not considered a formal Board within this Code, we wish to meet these high standards of probity.

Interests that are relevant and material

- a) Directorships, including non-executive directorships held in private companies or PLCs (with the exception of those of dormant companies).
- b) Ownership or part-ownership of private companies, businesses or consultancies likely or possibly seeking to do business with the NHS.
- c) Majority or controlling shareholdings in organisations likely or possibly seeking to do business with the NHS.
- d) A position of authority in a charity or voluntary organisation in the field of health and social care.
- e) Any connection with a voluntary or other organisation contracting for NHS services.
- f) Research funding/grants that may be received by an individual or their department.
- g) Interests in pooled funds that are under separate management.

Any member of the PPI Senate who comes to know that the EMAHSN has entered into or proposes to enter into a contract in which he or any person connected with him (as defined in Nottingham University Hospital NHS Trust's Standing Orders) has any pecuniary interest, direct or indirect, shall declare his interest by giving notice in writing of such fact to the Trust as soon as practicable.

All declared interests will be formally recorded in a Register of Interests which will be open to public inspection.

PPI Senate Members who have no interests to declare must make a 'nil declaration'.
